

Rules for General Use of YLPEC

1. NO HORSES INSIDE BARN FOR ANY REASON. Inside stall doors are to be kept closed, but not locked. No horse is permitted in main barn area ever and is never to enter or exit stall through the barn. Barn doors are to be kept closed when not in use.
2. Proper footwear must be worn (regardless of riding style) at all times when mounted or working with horses. Shoes/boots must have a heel.
3. Anyone jumping (regardless of age) must wear an approved ASTM-SEI safety helmet with properly adjusted chin harness.
4. Anyone under the age of 16 years must wear a helmet when riding (when California law changes we will comply).
5. When riding a horse, the horse must have a bridle and bit or bosal. Horses will not be loose.
6. All people in arenas with a horse must have the horse under control.
7. Horses can only be tied to tie rails or cross ties.
8. Please be considerate of other riders. No disruptive behavior will be tolerated.
9. There is to be no climbing in trees, playing in jump/barrel storage area, climbing or sitting on fences, riding on gates or entering feed lots or stalls of other boarders.
10. No one is to play with rakes, shovels, wheel barrows or any other tools.
11. Horses may **only be walked** in the barn area.
12. Clean up any mess you or your horse makes when using wash/groom tie rails as you make it. Please do not wait until the end of the day. This includes mane pulling, shaving, hoof trimmings, shedding.
13. Trash is to be placed in proper receptacles. Hay is never put in dumpster.
14. Wheel barrows are to be returned to the barn entrance after each use.
15. All hoses are to be wound up after each use.
16. No grooming in arenas.
17. Use proper riding etiquette. Notify any rider in arena that you are entering or exiting arena. **Arenas are not for private use** unless previously arranged with YLPEC.
18. Do not ride in front of jumps when riding in arenas with other riders.
19. When trail riding off the main YLPEC grounds, boarders are strongly encouraged to ride with someone else. If you go out alone please put a note on the white board with your intended route, time of departure and take a cell phone if you have one.
20. Due to the required income generated by horse shows and gymkhanas, and clinics, arenas will be closed to turnout 2 hours prior to event until event is ended in its entirety.
21. Tack Rooms are to be kept neat and locked when not in use.
22. All exterior gates are to remain closed at all times, except when in use.
23. The corner triangle turnout arena cannot be used when riders are in the upper arena. This arena is for turnout only.
24. All arenas are to be used on a first come, first serve basis. Consideration should be given to others waiting to use arenas.
25. Horses will not be left unattended in the arenas.
26. Turn out is not to exceed thirty (30) minutes, unless no one is waiting for the arena. Please notify any riders in any of the arenas if you are turning out any horse.
27. Arenas are to be sprinkled with water before use.
28. No feeding and or grooming are allowed in the arenas.
29. All jumps, barrels, cones, etc. shall be removed from arenas after each use.
